# **ACCEPTED**

# **BACKGROUND**

Priors Bus Service have raised the issue of cars parking within the bus zone on Melaleuca Crescent, Catalina.

When cars park within the Bus Zone opposite no. 7 Melaleuca Crescent, bus operators are unbale to stop close enough to the kerb where they can lower the bus and put out ramps to assist disabled and vision impaired customers.

Installing Bus Zone signs at this location would ensure motorists do not park within the bus zone, improving accessibility during pick up and set down for disabled and vision impaired customers.
